Parent Contract

We would like to take a moment to let all parents have a better understanding of their part in helping us have a successful baseball year.

Problem Solving:

If there is a problem between you and the coach there are steps you can follow to get a satisfactory result:

1. Approach the coach about it.
2. Approach the League commissioner with the complaint.

Remember to teach your child good sportsmanship by practicing it yourself! Children learn by example and you, as their parent, need to set the best one.

Parent Commitment:

You, as a parent, are responsible for making sure your child makes it to all practices and games. It is critical for the team to be able to all work together, for the players to know what is going on and learn how to use the equipment properly & safely. By signing your child up for baseball you agree to make sure your child gets to all practices and games. If your child misses practices without a good reason (i.e. illness, vacation, etc.) then the coach, at his/her discretion, can keep your child out of the next game. This is to ensure that you, as a parent, will try your best to get your child to all the required practices. Parents need to be prompt about picking their child up at the scheduled time from both practices and games, it is not the coach's responsibility to stay and wait for you to get your child or to take your child home.

Uniforms:

**Your child is required to wear the team cap and team shirt.
Coach Pitch, Mustang, Bronco & Pony leagues must also wear GRAY
baseball pants to each and every game.**

Our sponsors pay for the shirts and hats and then some, we need to show our appreciation and respect, it is everyone's responsibility to look and act like a team. If your child is not in full uniform he/she will not be allowed to play in that game until he/she has full uniform on. Please make sure your child comes to the game in full uniform. If you have to go home to get the full uniform and are not back by 15 min. after the game's start time, and your team doesn't have enough players, your child's team will be required to forfeit.

There will be no exceptions and no special circumstances.
